3 December 2026	Should we eat more venison?	The UK produces less of its own food than it used to and prices are increasing. Should we make more use of animals that might need culling.
12 December 2026	Why do we conform?	Businesses close for things like a state funeral, often at considerable cost. Why is there so little resistance to this practice?
8 January 2027	Lies and spin	How is news presented by the various media outlets and does this significantly influence public opinion?
17 January 2027	Excuses and scapegoats	How much do people blame government or other organisations for their own shortcomings?
